

How do I write a book?

Here's a rough timeline:

Edit and revise

Look over your draft for spelling mistakes and grammar slip-ups. Ask a friend or adult to read your story too - they might have helpful suggestions!

Block it out

Time to shape your story! Use the story map and story boards to plan out the beginning, middle, and end of your tale. This will help you see the story's big picture before you start writing.

Find your inspiration

Inspiration can come from anywhere - a movie, a dream, even a walk in the park! If you're feeling stuck, check out the story prompts list provided to get those creative wheels turning.

Present your final product

Now it's time to create your official book! Write your polished draft in the blank storybook. Use a pencil and write lightly so you can fix any little errors. Add colorful illustrations to make your story shine!

Write your 1st draft

Find a blank sheet of paper and start writing your story! Don't write directly in your blank storybook yet - this is where you can make mistakes, erase, and try new things. You can also sketch out some illustration ideas!

Compile your ideas

Grab the brainstorm sheet and start scribbling! Write down everything you can think of: characters, settings, anything goes! It doesn't have to be neat, just get your ideas out on paper.
